| Hawaii          | \$5000 for CED (IT) and \$2500 for TV manufacturer (or \$7500 if both TV manufacturer and other CED manufacturer)  | 1-Jan           | computers, printers, monitors and televisions   | Manufacturers who manufacture 100 or fewer computers per year are exempt from this law. Note: Exemption is not based on sales. Manufacturers who sell 100 or fewer computers per year in Hawaii, yet manufacture more than 100 computers per year, are not exempt from this law. Exemption does not apply to printers or monitors (or televisions).   |
| Illinois        | \$5,000  | 1-Jul           | Manufacturers of computer, monitor, television, or printer  | Law only requires those manufacturers wishing to sell their electronic products in the State to register with the State, and pay the registration fee. However, the Illinois EPA will set an annual recycling goal for computer/monitor/printer manufacturers with past products represented in return share data. Beginning in 2012, manufacturers will also pay shortfall penalties based on the percentage of their annual goal attained.        |
| Maine           | \$3,000  | 1-Jul           | Manufacturers of desktop printers, video game consoles, digital picture frames, portable computers, computer monitors, televisions, and/or portable DVD players sold to households  | The fee does not apply to manufacturers of televisions or game consoles that ceased all sales prior to January 1, 2010. It also does not apply to manufacturers of computer monitors, portable notebook computers, desktop printers or digital picture frames if a manufacturer ceased all sales prior to January 1, 2010 and less than 50 units of a manufacturer's product were recycled through Maine's e-waste program in the past three years. |
| Maryland        | \$5000 or \$500  | 1-Jan           | Manufacturers of televisions, computers, and computer monitors  | Only applies to a manufacturer that manufactured an average of more than one thousand covered electronic devices per year in the three-year period immediately preceding the initial registration   |

| North Carolina  | \$10,000 initial IT, then \$1000; \$2500 initial and annual TV   | 1-Jul           | TV and computer manufacturers   | A television manufacturer that sells 1,000 televisions or less per year is exempt from the requirement to pay the registration fee. A manufacturer of computer equipment that sells 1,000 items of computer equipment or less per year is exempt from the requirement to pay the registration fee   |
| New Jersey      | \$5000 (or \$10,000 if both TV manufacturer and other CED manufacturer)  | 1-Jan           | manufacturers of monitors, desktop computers, laptop computers, televisions   |   |
