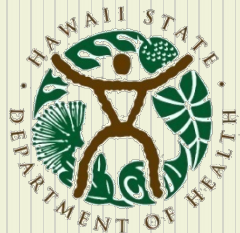
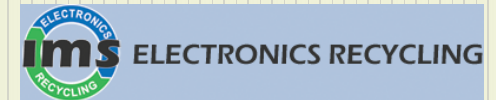

Bylaws of the Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse (ERCC) Adopted XXX

Members

The ERCC shall have the following types of membership:

VOTING:

Any State, Territory, or Commonwealth of the United States, or the District of Columbia, or local government that has adopted electronics recycling legislation.

AFFILIATE (Non-Voting):

Industry: Any industry, corporation, business, or other for profit organization

Trade Association: Any organization, whether for profit or non-profit, representing industry, business, or corporations.

Non-Governmental Organization: Any organization holding not-for-profit [tax-exempt] status and whose mission is environmental advocacy.

Foreign Government: Any official representative of a government other than that of the United States

Affiliate Government: Any Federal government agency, State, Territory, or Commonwealth of the United States, or the District of Columbia, or local government that has not adopted electronics recycling legislation

Role of Affiliate Members

All Affiliate Members may participate in ERCC calls and meetings, and provide information on relevant ERCC activities or decisions. Affiliate Members shall not have voting rights. Affiliate Members may be excluded from calls and meetings, or portions thereof, upon request of one or more Voting Members when it is determined that sensitive matters of regulatory concern will be

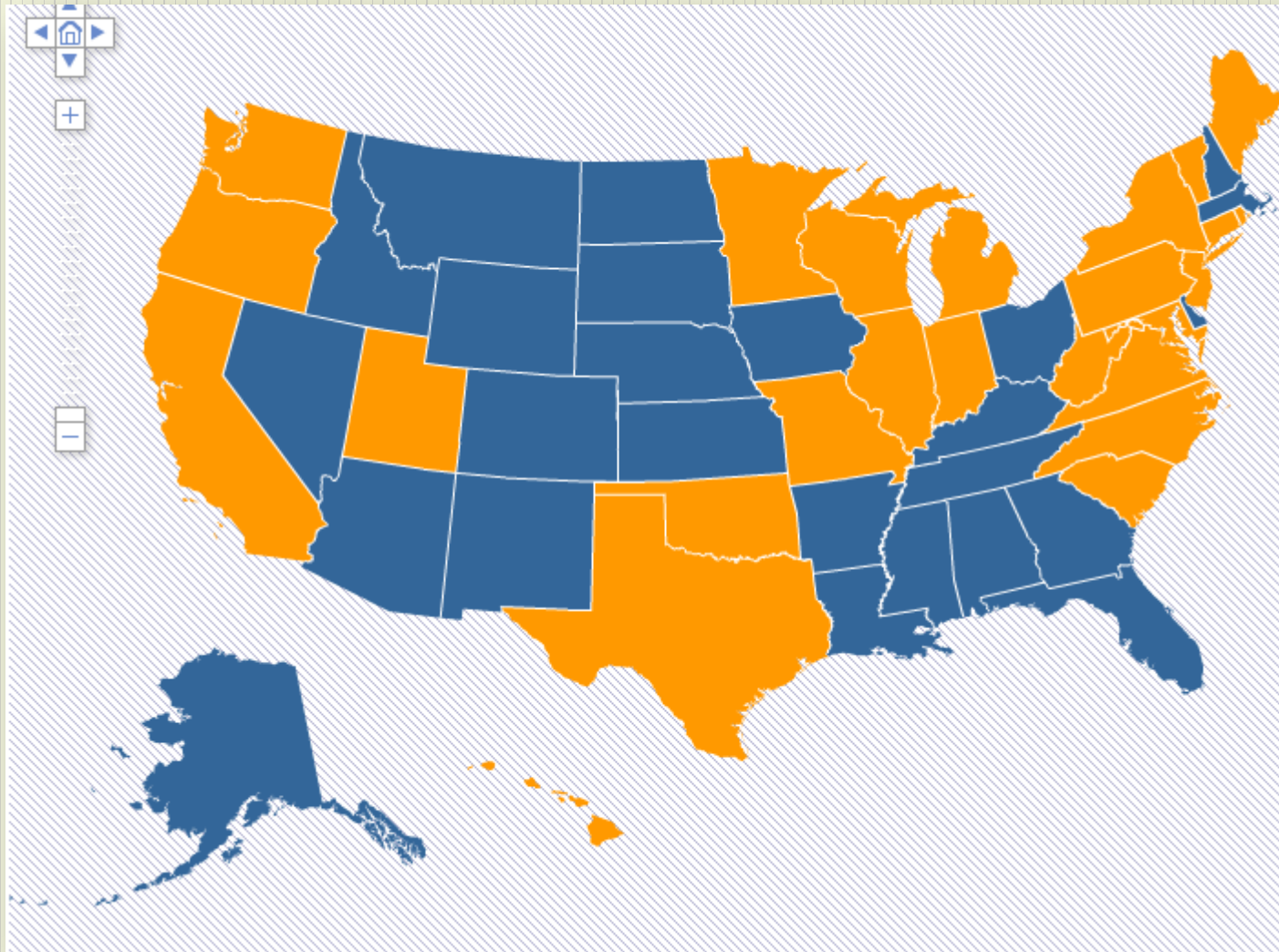
ERCC Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse

The mission of the Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse is to provide a forum for information exchange among state agencies implementing electronics recycling laws and all impacted stakeholders.

The Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse (ERCC) was launched in 2010 by two leading non-profit organizations advancing recycling efforts across the country - the [National Center for Electronics Recycling \(NCER\)](#) and the [Northeast Recycling Council \(NERC\)](#). The ERCC is a forum for coordination and information exchange among the state/local agencies that are implementing electronics recycling laws and all impacted stakeholders.

The ERCC is divided into two basic types of membership. The first are the voting members, who are states and local governments that are implementing electronics recycling laws. The ERCC also includes an affiliate, non-voting membership consisting of industry and other organizations. The ERCC is modeled on the successful organization currently managed by NERC known as the Toxics in Packaging Clearinghouse (TPCH). TPCH has demonstrated over the years that providing this type of coordination can provide benefits to and reduce costs for state governments and the regulated community in addition to providing

Section 1: Introduction, objective of the Request for Proposal (RFP), and background documents

1.1 Introduction

The Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse coordinates activities for members from state governments and other stakeholders who are implementing and complying with state electronics recycling laws. There are 25 states with laws on electronics recycling as mid-2011, and 16 of these require the use of market sales data for some or all of a manufacturer's recycling obligation. In some cases market share is used for the purposes of determining the annual registration fee, and in other cases it sets the manufacturer's overall collection goal for the year. However, all states vary in the number of product categories and market segments covered, as well as the timeframe for the sales period. These states laws therefore require a reliable and cost-effective source of data on the units shipped or sold during a given annual period.

1.2. Objective of the RFP

Collection Site Best Practices



Collections Site Best Practices September 2011

Introduction: *This document is intended to harmonize a set of Best Management Practices for collection sites that accept used electronics from covered entities under programs established by state electronics recycling laws. However, the Best Management Practices may also apply and be used by collection sites operating outside of state programs*

Collector definition: entities that offer sites for receiving and/or consolidating used electronics prior to sending it to recyclers or consolidators. A collector is not involved in the disassembly, demanufacture or recycling of electronics¹.

Best Practices/Requirements

1. Compliance

Comply with all applicable local, state, and federal requirements, including but not limited to environmental, health, and safety requirements;

Be willing to disclose fines received and notices of violation to upstream/downstream partners, such as recyclers, manufacturers, or others if any collection site receives a fine or notice of violation that is not

Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse Recommends Performance Measures for State Electronics Recycling Programs

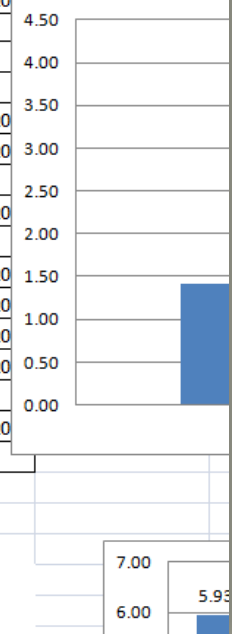
Parkersburg, W.Va. – April 25, 2011 –The Electronics Recycling Coordination Clearinghouse (ERCC) is releasing today its set of “best practices” for measuring the performance of state electronics recycling programs. As the number of state, manufacturer, and retailer-sponsored recycling programs has grown, so too has the desire to compare the different approaches to determine which are the most effective.

The new ERCC publication, which was developed with input from public and private stakeholder members of the ERCC, addresses this gap by recommending a standard set of metrics that can be used to develop a coherent baseline set of data. The need for harmonized performance measures was identified as the top priority at a workshop held by the ERCC at the September |
2010 E-Screen Conference.

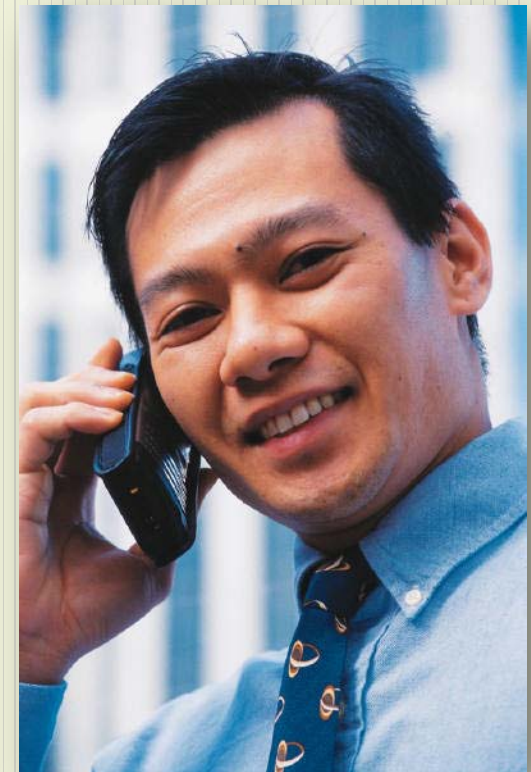
